LIBRARY

The college library has a vast collection of book, including latest editions. All students must follow the following library rules.

- Students can borrow two books at a time for fourteen days.
- A fine of RS.1/per day/per book is charged for not returning the book within due date.
- Reference books, picture books, books printed before 1975 and books having price more than 1000 Rupees are not issued.
- Books issued cannot be transferred to any other's library card.
- If the issued books are torn off or lost, it must either be replaced or a fine amounting one to four times of the original price is charged. For rare and very old books ten times of the original price is charged. If the lost book is from a set of books, the price of full set will be charged.
- It is the responsibility of the students to check the book thoroughly before borrowing. The librarian must be informed about the condition of the book immediately, otherwise the student will be held responsible for the conditions of the books.
- Library card must be presented to the library staff prior to get only book issued.
- Books can be re-issued after fourteen days only if no other student demands it.
- Indiscipline, misbehavior, or causing any disturbance in library would result in severe penalty.
- Library security is refundable when the security fund is forfeited.

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COLLEGE AND STUDENT'S DISCIPLINE

1. Students are expected to come to the college in neat, clean and simple clothes. They must conform to the high standards of modesty maintained by the institutions. They should not wear gaudy dresses.
2. Students should not bring discredit to the college or to themselves. Insubordination and rude behavior of any kind inside or outside the college will be severely dealt with.
3. Students should be regular and punctual in attending the classes and all activities connected with the college. No student is allowed to enter the classroom or leave the class room during class hours without the permission of the principal. They are not permitted to go out during lunch break.
4. Strict silence should be maintained during class hours in the Classrooms, Library, Laboratory, Examination halls and in the College premises.
5. Use of books, magazines and other materials not approved by the principal will not be permitted in the college campus.
6. All lost property should be brought to the college office.
7. Students are expected to take care of the college property and help in keeping the premises neat and clean. Disfiguring of walls, doors or breaking the furniture is a breach of discipline and will not be tolerated.
8. Students are forbidden from organizing any meeting in the college premises or collecting money for any purpose without the permission of the principal.
9. Students are not permitted to entertain the visitors in the college during the working hours. They are strictly forbidden from receiving personal phone calls or letters.
10. Student should not enter the office room, staff room or computer lab without permission.
11. Monthly tests and model examinations are part of curriculum and student should be sincere in taking these tests. They should not indulge in any kind of malpractice during examinations or tests.
12. Students must abide by the rules and regulations in force as well as other rules prescribed by the college from time to time. Thus, in the interest of the students, strict discipline has become the watch word of the college.
13. Students who do not follow the college rules and regulations will be expelled from the college.

COLLEGE UNIFORM FOR BS CLASSES

Students will be informed during the admission.

- 1- If the student remains absent from the class for 6 consecutive days or 10 days in a calendar month without application, his name will be struck off from the college. He can apply for re-admission only once in a session after depositing the mandatory re-admission fee as per rules.
- 2- Such students must get themselves readmitted within 15 days after being struck off from the college the college, otherwise an additional fine of RS.20 per day will also be charged along with normal re-admission fee.
- 3- At least 75% attendance is required for a student's candidature to appear in Board/university examination. Consative

- 1- Students must appear in the monthly class test held regularly.
- 2- Mid-term test will be held in December for all classes.
- 3- Sent-up test is held for students of all classes in March.
- 4- All the admissions for Board/University are sent provisionally and may be withdrawn prior to examination if student's attendance is less than 75% in any subject or he fails to pass his sent up test.

Every student academic performance is monitored through regular test on monthly basis. These test not only enhance learning and revision of the course studied in the previous month but also help teachers to further strengthen the weaker areas of students. Parents of the students are also made informed about the monthly test performance of their children.

Students are given regular assignments to reinforce topics covered in the class .This strengthens learning , thereby providing students a thorough revision of the topic .we pay special attention to the quality stuff in assignments submitted by students.

Send up examinations are conducted once a year just before the Board /University annual exams. These exams are very helpful in preparing students for the final exam of their respective program of study .If study do not perform well in the send ups, their admission to the University Board Exam is taken as a matter of serious concern.
